Trustees Update

Trustees continue to review and make suggestions for the completion of the church Safety and Security Plan.

Recent heavy rains revealed a large leak in an apartment ceiling. Inspection revealed the roof to be in very poor condition, and the Trustees accepted a bid to replace the roof.

Another recent lightning strike has damaged several electrical components in the church. Surge protectors installed last year helped minimize damage. Repairs underway.

Exterior sanctuary painting project has begun. Estimate 6-8 weeks to complete.

Exterior plantings need daily watering because of current heat wave. Trustees are volunteering to help, and church members are encouraged to volunteer by contacting Kathy Davis.

Necessary tree trimming and removal estimates received and tabled due to current unexpected costs.

Lightning Strike Update

On July 6th at 1:07am, the church experienced yet another lightning strike. Not only did it affect us, but it affected our neighboring Willis building as well. This time, we believe its traveling point was along the Spectrum internet line. Since our last strike on August 28, 2020, we have worked diligently at installing failsafes at locations surrounding the building. However like water, lightning has a way of finding a traveling line regardless. I do believe that because of our efforts the damage and interruptions were minimized. We are continuing to do our checks and to date we feel we have a good handle on where the damage occurred and we are working to resolve and fix issues. Our network, organ, security video and monitoring systems are functioning normally. We are waiting for some fixes for particular problem areas in the audio / video area and finance office. We appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to resolve all of the issues and apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
